This funding will be used to

1. In English, increase our A-C percentage to 90% or above.
2. In English, increase our A-B percentage to 50% or above.
3. In Writing, increase our A-C percentage to 90% or above.

Our initiatives include

- Partner with the Impact Center and University of QLD to improve our understanding and implementation of Critical Thinking.
- Provide targeted intervention including focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support in L2B and U3B based on data evidence in Prep to Year 6 from 2020.
- Provide focused, class teacher support to engage intensive teaching to extend high achieving students in Prep to Year 6.
- Provide Professional Development and coaching to ensure teachers' ability to understand and implement the school writing program.
- Increase teachers' repertoire of effective strategies for teaching writing.
- Extend collaborative data inquiry processes to build teachers' ability to interpret data, identify and scale-up effective teaching practices and embed effective differentiation strategies.
- Consolidate teacher capability in gathering and using evidence to determine the different year-level curriculum some students require to develop and successfully implement Individual Curriculum Plans.
- Support our EALD students with additional staffing FTE through our cluster based engagement.
- Support and access the MYCP at Vienna Woods SS for all families of students aged 6-9yrs who currently have behavioural and social difficulties in the classroom; and
- Continue our engagement of local early childhood centres and kindergartens to enhance knowledge of Prep expectations and to assist a smooth transition of children into Prep and Year 1.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

1. Engage Impact Centre to engage our staff in critical thinking strategies. This includes Face to Face whole staff, focused group and individual support. **\$10 000**
2. Employing a Support Teacher .6 FTE to support EALD and Learning Support Intervention. **\$60 000**
3. Employing a Project Teacher 1.0 FTE to support teachers to deliver a targeted approach to engaged enrichment in Literacy and Numeracy. **\$85 000**
4. Consolidating a Head of Targeted Intervention to manage and co-ordinate support staff and programs.
5. Employing 2 teacher aides to support the targeted intervention. **\$96 000**
6. Employing a Teacher Aide 5hrs per week to assist Support Teacher-Extension. **\$9600**
7. Purchasing specific writing resources. **\$2132**
